Research reveals the power of energy released by hands

Energy released by hands can aid all kinds of treatments, says research by USP.



A study recently developed by USP (University of São Paulo), together with UNIFESP (Federal University of São Paulo), proves that the energy released by hand has the power to cure any kind of discomfort. The work was done according to techniques already known by many, like Johrei, used by the Church of World Messianity, and at the same time similar to religions such as Spiritism, practicing the so-called "pass".

All of this research and development process started in 2000 as a master's degree program theme by the researcher Ricardo Monezi, from USP's Medical School. He took the initiative to investigate what are the possible effects of this laying on of the hands practice. "This interest came from my own experience, when the practice of Reiki had helped me during my adolescence, out of a depression crisis", said Monezi, now a researcher at UNIFESP.

According to this scientist, during his master's degree studies he investigated the effects of the laying on of the hands on mice, when he observed a remarkable improvement of the defense cells against tumor cells. "Now, as my doctoral work is being finalized at UNIFESP, we studied not only the physiological effects but also the psychological," he added.

The findings in this study identified that the laying on of hands releases energy and is capable of healing even though the current science does not have an exact measure about this effect. "Science calls these energies "subtle energies", and also considers the space in which they operate is close to low-level electromagnetic frequencies," he explained.

The sensations provided by these practices as analyzed by Monezi showed the reduction of the perception of tension, stress and symptoms related to anxiety and

depression. "The interesting thing is that this type of practice provides the feeling of relaxation and fulfillment. In addition, it brings more energy and disposition."

This master's degree dissertation study used 60 mice. However, for the doctoral study 44 elderly patients with stress complaints were evaluated.

The research and development process that made this doctoral study was completed in the first half of this year. UNIFESP is about to start new investigations on the effects of Reiki and similar practices beginning April of next year.
